SPECIAL GRANTS APPLICATION RULES

The Schubert Club provides grants to serious, talented musicians in need of financial assistance to further their musical development. Most grants are \$500. The cost of on-going lessons, on-going school tuition, transportation and housing are not supported by Special Grants.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. The applicant must be no younger than 12 years old and no older than 30 years old on May 2, 2011 and a resident of Minnesota, Iowa, North Dakota, South Dakota or Wisconsin.
2. The applicant must submit a complete Special Grants application. **DO NOT ATTACH A RESUME OR CURRICULUM VITAE.**
3. The applicant must submit two letters of recommendation, one from the applicant's current music teacher and one from another person unrelated to the applicant.
4. The applicant must submit a letter of introduction (maximum of 300 words) which includes additional relevant biographical information, long-term musical goals and circumstances that make total payment for your project difficult by you or your family.
5. The applicant must NOT have been awarded a scholarship prize in the 2011 Schubert Club Bruce P. Carlson Student Scholarship Competition.

DEADLINE

Completed applications including letters of recommendation must be *received* before 4:30 pm, Monday, May 2, 2011 at The Schubert Club office: 302 Landmark Center, 75 W. 5th Street, Saint Paul, MN, 55102. APPLICATION REVIEW

The Special Grants Committee meets in early May to review applications and to recommend awards.

AWARDS

Recipients of Special Grants will be notified the week of May 16. Award checks will be issued without delay to the individual or program as specified on the recipient's application.

ACCOUNTABILITY

Special Grant recipients must provide a written, final report to the Special Grants Committee by Sept. 9, 2011. Failure to do so will remove the recipient from future grant and Student Scholarship Competition eligibility. A Final Report Form will be mailed to each Special Grant recipient.
