ST. PAUL, MN (November 2, 2011) – The Schubert Club has published a beautiful new book by Minneapolis photographer Natasha D' Schommer, *To Music: The Schubert Club Museum*, available for \$35.

A reception and book signing open to the public will take place on Sunday, November 13, 1:00-3:00 PM at The Schubert Club Museum on the second floor of Landmark Center in downtown Saint Paul. Copies of the book will be available at the event at a special reduced price and a drawing will be held for a framed D'Schommer print.

Visitors to The Schubert Club Museum know D'Schommer's work from the mural-sized photo-enlargements that grace the gallery walls. D'Schommer's artistry elegantly reveals intimate details of many fascinating objects in the Museum's collection: manuscripts, keyboards and instruments from around the world.

In the course of producing the photographic murals for the Museum, D'Schommer created hundreds of beautiful images, only a handful of which could be used there. This new hardcover book gives the public the opportunity to appreciate a larger selection of D'Schommer's arresting images—more than seventy, most in full color.
